

## Public lecture with Max Dudler

A public event with discussions, encounters and exchange from 19.00 closes the International Conference on 4 June 2013 which takes place in the Unesco World Heritage-Site Upper Middle Rhine Valley. Max Dudler will talk about "Further Construction".

Max Dudler was born in Altenrhein in Switzerland. He studied Architecture at the Städelschule in Frankfurt/Main with Günter Bock and at the University of Fine Arts in Berlin with Ludwig Leo. He worked at the offices of Oswald Matthias Unger until 1986 when he founded a company together with Karl Dudler and Pete Wellenberg. Since 1992 he has run his own company with branches in Berlin, Zürich and Frankfurt/Main. After several lectureships and visiting professorships ie. in Venice, Mantua, Dortmund and Vienna Max Dudler was appointed Professor for Architecture at the Academy of Arts in Düsseldorf in 2004.



*„It is an odd thing with these monuments. On the one hand a historic monument visualizes the gap between the past and the present day but on the other hand it also reminds us of our duty to deal with our history. That is why the task and topic “Construction in existing buildings” leads me to search for a kind of architecture that continues history without reconstructing or restoring it. This quest of searching for something new, which would not be possible or thinkable without the old, is what I call “Further Construction”.*
